## **Event Parking Options**

## Parking for Special Events during Garage Hours

First Congregational United Church of Christ's facility is part of a multi-use development at 10<sup>th</sup> and G Streets that includes a multi-level, underground parking garage. The garage entrance is at the back of the building; use 980 G Place, N.W., for GPS directions. There are 95 non-reserved spaces available. However, during the business day, most of these spaces are leased to monthly parkers by the garage operator. Parking during the business day is tight and the church cannot guarantee that there will be any parking spaces available.

**Hours:** The garage is open to the public Monday – Friday, 6:00 am - 11:00 pm.

**DailyRates:** Up to one hour, \$10.

Up to two hours, \$16. Daily maximum, \$18.

Overnight, \$36

Event Rate: \$10 for weekday evenings if entering after 5:00 pm. This rate may also be

available for weekend events by arrangement with the garage operator.

You and your attendees must take care **NOT** to fold, mutilate, crinkle, spindle, etc. your parking ticket. Doing so makes them inoperable and the garage operator will charge you the maximum to get out of the garage.

## Parking for Special Events Outside of Garage Hours

If you are holding an event on the weekend, you may contract with the church to have the garage open at a cost of \$50 per hour (with a four-hour minimum) to cover the garage utilities and staff.

Your attendees are then responsible for the individual parking fees as noted above. They may be paid by credit/debit card or cash at the kiosk on P1 located next to the entrance to the office elevator lobby, or by credit/debit card at the exit gate. Usually, the garage operator will have a \$10 event parking rate on the weekend.

Please note the following:

- 1. ALL arrangements to have the garage open for your event must be made and paid for at least fourteen (14) calendar days before your event.
- 2. The church accepts no liability for your use of the garage.
- 3. The church is not responsible for any items stolen from attendees or vehicles in the garage.
